Father Phil's Ramblings

Retirement is supposed to be the "Golden Years."

Hmmmm.

Three weeks ago, I traveled to Charleston, South Carolina for a week of rest and relaxation. Instead, I found myself embarking on a journey of resting — but not exactly relaxing — in hospitals and emergency rooms.

Upon arrival in Charleston, I immediately headed to the nearest hospital. Without going into details, let's just say my malady is somewhat common to men of a certain age. My age. The ER staff performed a simple procedure that provided immediate relief. It was relief of a temporary nature, however, and as soon as I arrived home I found myself again in need of a trip to the ER.

Just last Monday, I was informed that surgery is needed in order to permanently take care of the problem. That surgery is scheduled for Wednesday, July 6 at Lutheran General Hospital.

If you have attended any Mass I have celebrated since my return from Charleston, you may have noticed that I've been unable to stand unassisted. This difficulty originates in my back and is yet another physical problem that must be investigated more thoroughly after my surgery on Wednesday.

I feel as though I am writing a doctor's report, but I also feel it's important to be candid about what is going on, and I ask you for your prayers, especially on Wednesday.

On to happier subjects.

Atremendous kudos to the picnic committee. This was our fourth year and everyone enjoyed the food, games and wonderful family environment. To see children — and so many little children — tells me that St. Juliana Parish is young, alive and thriving.

As of this writing, a new pastor has not been named. We remain ever hopeful that within the next few weeks, a man will be named to the position.

I thank Father Bob and Father Roger for doing double-duty because of my health issues. I feel guilty because I am unable to celebrate Mass. These two men both told me to just let them know when I needed help and finally I had to give in. Thank you both.

"You Have Hidden These From The Wise and Learned: You Have Revealed Them To Little Ones"

What are "these things" hidden from the wise and revealed to the little ones? Some years ago there was a best-seller written by Robert Fulgrum. The title was something like: "Everything I Need For Life I Learned in Kindergarten." I know that's not the exact title, but the gist is there.

It was a marvelous book. Mr. Fulgrum went about proving his "thesis" with home-spun wisdom and insight. He was of the opinion that the lessons of kindergarten were more than sufficient to see us through the rest of our lives. Things like: "Look both ways before crossing the street...hold the hands of kids younger than you when crossing the street...take a nap in the afternoon, or if you're not tired enough to sleep, just rest at your desk with your head in the crook of your arm...eat all your vegetables...say 'Please' and 'Thank you' and 'Excuse me'...never make jokes about how some other kid looks or speaks...get plenty of exercise, etc., etc."

The same sort of message was brought home to me in the recent film "Mad Hot Ballroom." It wasn't one of those big time "smasheroonies" that Hollywood is fond of these days. It was a film about some 5th graders in a particular school learning how to do ballroom dancing. It was like a documentary and traced the growth these youngsters went through in the course of being taught how to Samba, Rhumba, Swing and maybe Foxtrot (I can't remember if that last one was among the dances they learned.)

The thesis of the film was that learning to dance ballroom style necessitated learning the good manners that go along with a "gentleman" dancing with a "lady." The instructors always referred to the children as "Ladies and Gentlemen." Lo and behold! In the course of learning the intricacies of the dances, the children also imbibed respect for one another: "Look into each others' eyes...stand up straight; be proud of your partner...learn the steps exactly, with grace and rhythm...remember: no one is too short or too tall to be your partner; everyone is a person to be respected.

It tickled me to see the really serious life-lessons the mentors communicated to these children, most of them from poorer neighborhoods. As you would expect, there was a dance competition for which the youngsters prepared. What a marvel to see the "finished product" of the lessons. There were attitudinal changes in the 5th graders; they respected each other, spoke to each other as "ladies" and "gentleman," exactly what they had been called by their mentors. An inclusiveness grew in the whole group and they supported their friends who had been chosen to compete in the final contest. Their potentials to become gentle people had been brought to the fore in the simple regimen which would not allow them to settle for anything less than actually being "ladies and gentleman."

To learn as children; to live as children; to be oblivious to color or race; to be respectful of our partners, whoever they may be - even if they're taller or shorter than us.

Did you, perhaps, see the children at the Parish Picnic last Sunday? Now that's the way to live!
