### “THE PEARL OF GREAT PRICE”

“Unlike other precious stones, the pearl is (or once was) a living thing, a speck of foreign matter that found its way into the embryo. Instead of the intruder being rejected, it was wrapped by the mother in ‘swaddling clothes,’ nurtured and, in the end, became precious beyond our wildest dreams.”

Author Fred Sherrer thus describes the origins of a pearl. Its beginnings are parasitic; it takes up residence in a shell and lives off of nutrients it finds there. It slowly grows into a pearl, a gem of great beauty and value.

Yesterday, July 26th, was the Feast of Sts. Anne and Joachim, the Grandma and Grandpa of Jesus, the parents of Mary, the Mother-in-law and Father-in-law of Joseph. This year, my own Grandparents come powerfully to mind, because my brother Phil and I had gone to Poland where the seeds of our family were planted. Oh, Dad’s people were from Ostrava in the Czech Republic but that was just a short distance from southern Poland the town of Oswiecim where Mom’s people were from.

We didn’t have time to scout our exact locations of family but the days in Krakow and Zakopane and environs were a special Grace for us. It was like returning to a place we had been in before in “some other life.” In a profound way, it all seemed so familiar to us, as if we were among “our own.” It was easy to conjure up images of our Grandparents. Only our Mom’s Mother was alive and healthy in our childhood, though Dad’s Mom also had lived with us before her death in 1945.

To see the country and places where our Grandparents had been nurtured, the seeds of their Faith planted and

strengthened by their own parents and Grandparents. It was a great Grace to experience the mountains, valleys, history of a place that lived only in our DNA and genetic make-up up till then. In a way, our Grandparents came alive; we could appreciate the hardships of their travels, their adventuresomeness, their trust in God.

I’m sure this echoes the story of so many of you. We are the fruit of our Grandparents’ love, as much as we are of our Parents’ love. In the “oyster” of our families and their traditions and faith, we have been nourished and formed. Stories of the faith and courage of our Grandparents have helped give us an identity, even if we have never met them in person. We know that our value and the values we hold strongly have been, in some sense, fashioned by those who have gone before.

Jesus learned to love and believe in the Father’s love for Him at the feet of His Grandparents and Parents. He learned how to put Divinity into human words and actions.

Passing of the Pearl of Great Price is the Mission of all of us. We do not find the treasure in order to hide it, so that we may buy it for ourselves. Our Grandparents tried to give us the best of themselves. We can do no better than imitate them.

If you’re fortunate enough to have your Grandparents still alive in your family, give them a call or “blog” or a visit and tell them: “Grandma and Grandpa, I like being like you! You have given me a history!!”

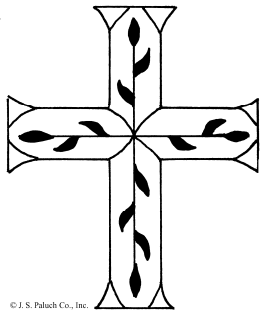

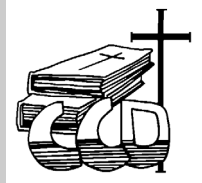

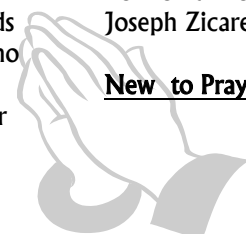
